

Cornerstone Arts Centre Competition

Terms and Conditions

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1. This competition is owned and managed by South Oxfordshire District Council who run Cornerstone Arts Centre and whose registered office is at Abbey House, Abbey Close, Abingdon OX14 3JE
2. The competition is open to residents of the United Kingdom except
 - (a) employees of South Oxfordshire and Vale of White Horse District Council
 - (b) anyone otherwise connected with the Council
 - (c) anyone judging the competition
 - (d) anyone who may have been involved with donations towards the competition or
 - (e) members of the immediate families or households of (a)(b)(c) and (d) above
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
4. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions. The Council reserve the right to refuse entry or to refuse to award a prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions

10. The Council reserve the right to hold void, suspend, cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice, where it becomes necessary to do so. Any changes to the competition terms and conditions will be notified to entrants as soon as practicable.
11. The prize is as stated and no cash or other alternatives will be offered. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability and we reserve the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
12. Names will be selected at random on or before **Monday 27 July 2026** using an independent online tool.

If a winner cannot be contacted or does not respond to claim the prize within 14 days of notification, the Council reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and select a replacement winner in accordance with the procedure described above.
14. Winners will receive a voucher that can be emailed to the recipient or collected from the Cornerstone Arts Centre box office depending on their preference. We will require proof of identity upon collection such as evidence of the email address, drivers licence etc
15. The Council's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Council will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate a winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Council or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.
17. The competition and these terms and conditions will be governed by English law and any court proceedings will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England.
