

South Oxfordshire and Vale of White Horse District Councils Reduce and Reuse Waste Quiz 2024

Terms and Conditions

1. This prize draw is organised by South Oxfordshire and Vale of White Horse District Councils ("the Councils") of Abbey House, Abbey Close, Abingdon OX14 3JE.

How to enter

2. Entries must be made online after completing the quiz in full at https://theconversation.southandvale.gov.uk/housing-and-environment/festive_quiz
3. Entries received without a completed quiz will not be counted.
4. All entries must be submitted by 11:59pm on Sunday 5 January 2025. The prize draw is free to enter, and no purchase is necessary.
5. By submitting an entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The Council may refuse an entry or refuse to award a prize to anyone who breaches these Terms and Conditions.
6. The opening date for entries is Monday 2 December 2024. The closing date of the prize draw is 11:59pm on Sunday 5 January 2024. Entries received after this time will not be counted.
7. The Councils do not accept any responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault of any kind.

Eligibility

8. The prize draw is open to any resident of South Oxfordshire or Vale of White Horse districts, who is over 16 years old, except employees of the Councils.
9. There is only one entry per person.
10. Entrants under the age of 18 must have consent from their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) before entering. The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of entrants under the age of 18 agree to these Terms and Conditions on behalf of the entrant. Proof of parental/guardianship responsibility may be requested.

The Draw

11. One winner from each district will be chosen by random draw within one week of the prize draw ending at 11:59pm on Sunday 5 January 2024.

12. The winner will be contacted within 7 days of being chosen, using the email address provided at entry. The winner must respond within 7 days and must provide a postal address to claim their prize. If the winner does not respond within 14 days, the Councils will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.

13. The Council must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation the Council must send the surname and county of the winners, to anyone who requests details by email from the Council within one month after the closing date of the competition. The winner therefore consents to their surname, and town/county details being published and/or made available in the event that the Councils are required to do so to comply with this obligation of the Advertising Standards Authority. In such circumstances, the Councils must still provide the information on winning entries to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

14. The prize will be delivered to the winner within 7 days of responding to the Councils and providing a postal address.

15. One winner from each district will receive a voucher worth £36 for a series of 4 Art Workshops at Cornerstone, Didcot.

18. The Councils reserve the right to hold, void, cancel, suspend or amend the promotion where it becomes necessary to do so.

Limitation of liability

19. Insofar as is permitted by law, the Councils will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize, except where it is caused by the negligence of the Councils. Your statutory

rights are not affected.

Data protection

20. The Councils will only use the personal information provided in accordance with these terms and conditions, as agreed to by the entrant in the quiz, and in accordance with the Councils' consultation privacy policy and current UK data protection legislation.

By entering, you are providing your explicit consent that personal details provided may be held and used for the purpose of administering the competition and will be deleted once the prize has been received. Except for the winners, whose personal details may be used for the purposes of any required publishing or provision of the winners details under paragraph 13 above. Any winners personal details will be deleted within (two months) of completion of the competition.

General
